The second course can be added during the add/drop course stage.</p> <p>(2) 博雅課程：大二以上選修，每學期選修一門為原則，加退選階段可加選第 2 門。 Liberal arts courses: Elective for sophomore or above, one elective per semester in principle, and the second one can be added during the add/drop course stage.</p> <p>(3) 若一個學期不選修是可以的，只是同學要安排好其他學期修課進度，以免影響畢業時程。 It is okay if you do not take the above courses for a semester, but you should arrange the progress of other semesters so you don't affect the graduation schedule.</p>
